SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

THE FIRST HOUR OF 2026, WHILST MANY MAY BE ASLEEP HERALDS A NEW SET OF TIME FOR EVERYONE OF US. FOR SOME, TIME CREEPS IN QUIETLY AND UNNOTICEABLY. SOME MAY WATCH THE FIREWORKS TO CELEBRATE THE NEW YEAR. FOR SOME IT MAY JUST BE ANOTHER NEW YEAR, ANOTHER YEAR OLDER.

TIMES WAITS FOR NO MAN. CHRONOLOGICAL TIME WAITS FOR NO MAN. TIMES IS GIVEN EQUALLY; 24 HOURS A DAY. NO MORE NO LESS.

TODAY THE CHURCH CELEBRATES THE SOLEMNITY OF MARY, MOTHER OF GOD ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE NEW YEAR. THIS CAN BE TRACED TO THE COUNCIL OF EPHESUS IN 431. THIS IS ONE OF THE 4 DOGMATIC TEACHING OF THE CHURCH ON THE BLESSED VIRGIN.

THE CHURCH PRAYS THAT THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, WHOM THE COUNCIL DECLARED AS "THE BEARER OF GOD" AND WHO TOOK FLESH IN HER WOMB AT THE APPOINTED TIME IN HUMAN HISTORY, TO BE WITH US FROM THE NEW YEAR TILL THE END OF TIME. (GAL 4:4-7)

THE LORD (KYRIOS) AS POPE ST PAUL VI DECLARED; "MAY THE LORD UNCOVER HIS FACE TO YOU AND BRING YOU PEACE." (NUMBERS 6:22-27)

AS A FULFILMENT OF THE ANCIENT PROPHETS, THE PRINCE OF PEACE WAS BROUGHT INTO THE WORLD. BETTER THAN ANYONE ELSE, SHE KNEW THE PEACE THAT IS AT ONCE HER SON'S GIFT TO THE WORLD. O HOUSE OF JACOB, COME, LET US WALK IN THE LIGHT OF THE LORD. THIS WHAT HER SON WILL OFFER; THE FRUITS OF LIFE LIVED IN OBEDIENCE TO GOD.
