STS PETER AND PAULS OLD CATHEDRAL GOULBURN NSW

NATIONAL TRUST HERITAGE AWARD NOMINATION

The shortlist for the highly anticipated 29th annual National Trust Heritage Awards was announced in March, and featured more than 40 rich and diverse heritage projects spanning across New South Wales.

We were delighted that the restoration project for Sts Peter and Paul's Old Cathedral was shortlisted in two categories:

- "Conservation Built Heritage"
- "Conservation Interiors and Objects"

The winners were announced at the National Trust Heritage Awards ceremony on Friday 12 May in Sydney. Although our restoration project didn't take out first prize (that went to Bondi Pavilion!), we were delighted to receive a "Highly Commended" for the excellent conservation work on our Stations of the Cross. Well done team!

- Installation of digital signage in the Narthex.








YOU'RE INVITED TO OUR PARISH FEAST DAY ANNUAL DINNER!

PRESBYTERY POTENTIAL **POSSIBILITIES**



Eagle-eyed parishioners may have noticed a Development Application poster on the front fence of the Presbytery.

As part of the ongoing restoration and renewal of the Old Cathedral precinct, attention is now being given to the Presbytery, and potential future uses of the building. However, an important pre-requisite for any future use requires us to ensure that the building complies with the latest regulations.

The relevant Development Application is DA/0369/2223. The main components of the application involve improvements to electrical wiring, utilities, and the installation of a lift to the rear of the building. During this phase, our priests will relocate to the North Goulburn presbytery.


