### HISTORIC RELICS TO VISIT GOULBURN

2023 is the Golden Jubilee Year of the Australasian Eparchy of the Maronite Orthodox community, having been established 50 years ago in 1973. As part of their Jubilee Year, Maronites are touring around Australia with a unique religious artefact - a reliquary containing relics of five saints. The reliquary has been created by Lebanese-Australian sculptor Toufic Mourad.

Carved in the shape of a ship, the reliquary incorporates many religious symbols that highlight themes from the Maronite community. Inside the ship are relics of five saints - St Maroun, St Charbel, St Rafqa, St Nehmetallah, and St Mary of the Cross Mackillop.

The relics will visit Our Lady of Mercy Chapel in Goulburn on 7th and 8th October this year.
