# SACRAMENTAL NEWS



Over the years, the boundary wall on Bourke St has been gradually deteriorating, to the point of being at risk of collapse. We are grateful to Matthew Chamberlain and his team for donating labour and materials to restore this historic element of our parish estate.

It is hoped that this work will be completed soon after Easter. Once complete, a further stage of work will see the St Brigid's carpark re-sealed with new tarmac.

At the same time, remediation work has begun in the upper levels of St Brigid's, clearing out decades of pigeon carcasses, guano and other debris.


#### **FUNDRAISING NEWS**



A significant grant towards the restoration of Sts Peter and Paul's Old Cathedral was a preelection commitment from the Australian Once elected, the Federal Labor Party. Government acted on this commitment.

Through the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts, we have been awarded a grant of \$250,000.

The terms of the grant are specifically to address the costs of our new central heating system and associated costs. Hooray!
