Dear Parishioners,

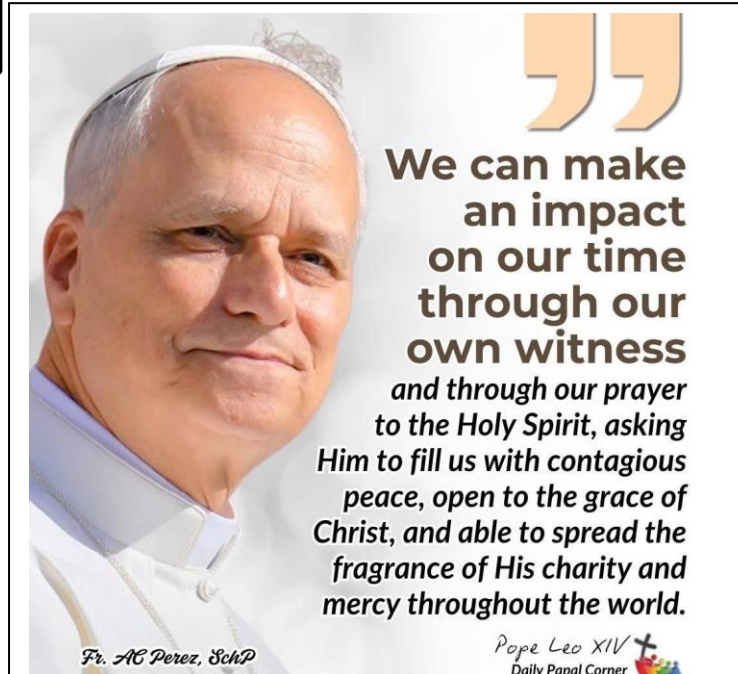
